

RECRUITING FAA BOARD MEMBERS

WHAT IS THE FUNCTION OF THE FAA BOARD OF DIRECTORS?

- To set policy for the organization
- To establish and monitor the budget
- To assist with promoting the scheduled events
- To help support the smooth-functioning of the scheduled events
- To help provide funding for the organization
- To help recruit new members
- To help recruit volunteers for positions such as pop-up gallery sitter, gallery/program committee, art fair committee, public relations, etc.

WHAT ARE THE OBLIGATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS?

- To attend Board Meetings and provide input on agenda items
- To attend scheduled events
- To represent FAA at various community events.
- To make an annual financial commitment of \$500.

CAN THE FINANCIAL COMMITMENT BE IN ANOTHER FORM BESIDES A ONE-TIME DONATION?

Yes. Members can make part of their donation to the Annual Fund Drive, join at a sponsorship level, help support the art fair as a donor or recruit 14 new members who all join at the \$35 level.... or recruit three new members who join at the \$200 level.... or identify and recruit a \$1,000 sponsor for an exhibit, or convince a business to donate \$500 as a grant.

This is not an organization that will drop a member who does not meet his/or her financial obligation but we do ask our members to help us find financial support and we establish a goal of \$500 pre member.

WHAT KINDS OF SKILLS ARE WE SEEKING IN A BOARD MEMBER?

All Boards need three kinds of members:

- Those who can make a financial commitment
- Those who have willing hands and time and can make a commitment to work
- Those who have many ties to the organizations and people of the greater community and can bring people into “the fold”
